However, during their monthly web meetings, the Board unanimously agreed that w have to do something to mark the occasion. 



- Suggestions to improve membership experience:



Current membership


• Currently we have 57 active memberships (42 Family; 15 Individual). There are more Inactive memberships (78) that have (and some of them still) participate and/or attend our events.
